Funding for this project would require looking into tax credits, No Place Like Home, and Ventura County Human Services.

- Council gave \$200,000 for the remaining year to Oxnard PD for additional overtime to focus on Downtown and will continue for the next 2 years.
- Lighting for the parking structure
- Demo of the laundry matt on 5th street, plan for the lot needed before demo is approved.

Baseline services meeting took place yesterday to have all departments in the city agree of services they would provide, will meet again to finalize the agreement. Retail for cannabis was approved for eight licenses. Billboard loft project filed November of last year, expect for approval in February.
